About correspondence to new coronavirus

At present, multiple outbreaks of new coronavirus-related pneumonia have been reported in Wuhan, Hubei Province, China. In Japan, several cases of outbreaks have been confirmed mainly in central Tokyo. However, the New Coronavirus Infectious Disease Control Headquarters was held in the Diet, and the spread of infection was suppressed by prompt response. .

The 2020 JCI Kanazawa Conference will be held from February 21 to 23, 2020, as originally planned.

Current status of new coronaviruses in Japan and Ishikawa Prefecture
In Japan, the new coronavirus infectious disease has been transmitted from person to
person in Japan, but the epidemic is not widespread at present. In addition, as of
February 4, 2020, there are no reports of people infected with the new coronavirus in
Ishikawa Prefecture.

Measures at JCI Kanazawa Conference 2020

(1) For members including overseas delegates, if you are not feeling well, such as fever, cough, runny nose, please participate.

I will inform you to forego it.

(2) Make sure you know what you can do for yourself, such as masks, gargles, and hand washing for prevention, and at the entrance.

Prepare to distribute masks.

(3) Alcohol at the entrance to the venue of the hokkoku shinbun akabane Hall and Kanazawa City Cultural Hall (specified in English and Japanese)
Install disinfectant.

- (4) An emergency contact for JCI Kanazawa Meeting 2020 will be established.
- (5) We will always gather information such as the government's response and make decisions on the event.
- (6) If fever or symptoms occur, cooperate with a medical institution so that they can respond quickly.

While we can never guarantee that traveling to Japan is risk free, we are committed to doing everything we can to protect participants from the new coronavirus.
